Everything you need to know before you go!

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Where do BSRI trips depart from?

All BSRI group trips depart from the Brunswick Center at Supply:

- 101 Stone Chimney Road, Supply, NC 28462

Free long-term parking is available for the duration of the trip.

How will I get updates about the trip?

You will receive important travel updates via phone call, email, or text message depending on your communication preferences. Be sure to keep your contact information current and check in regularly.

2. PAYMENTS & REGISTRATION

How do I pay for a trip?

Choose one of the following methods:

- Drop off a check or money order (no cash) at your **local BSRI Senior Center** (your "Port")
- Mail your payment directly to: **PML Travel & Tours 750 NJ-73, Suite 204 Evesham, NJ 08053**. Make checks payable to: PML Travel & Tours. **Please write the trip name on the memo line.**
- To pay by card, contact **Sandy Pace at 252-363-0696**. Credit card payments are strongly encouraged if you're concerned about processing delays.

3. TRIP PLANNING & DETAILS

Will I receive hotel and itinerary info in advance?

Yes! Once confirmed, we'll provide your hotel information and daily itinerary. However, please note that **changes may occur** due to group size or operational needs.

- Please read each trip flyer carefully, as it includes essential information about pricing, including activities, deadlines, insurance, activity level, and mobility expectations.

Do I need travel insurance?

- Travel protection is strongly recommended and must be purchased at the time of your deposit. Insurance is not refundable. Costs vary by trip and occupancy and are listed on the flyer.
- If you choose not to include travel insurance with your booking, you will be required to sign a **Trip Insurance Waiver**.

4. ROOMMATES, GROUP SIZE & MOBILITY

I'm traveling solo. Is it possible to be matched with a roommate?

PML does not match roommates, but **BSRI** can help connect interested solo travelers.

How many people are needed for the trip?

- Motorcoach trips: Minimum of 40 travelers
- Domestic air trips: Minimum of 30 (or 15 if combined with another group)
- International trips: Minimum of 20

What about mobility concerns?

Each trip flyer includes an **activity level guide**. If you have concerns about walking distances, uneven terrain, or pace, please reach out. We want to ensure that the experience is right for you.
